## Easter Egg Hunt:

Get ready for an old fashioned Easter Egg Hunt.....

Things you may need:  
Plastic, Card or Chocolate Easter Eggs.



This activity requires lots of listening, hide 6 eggs in and around a room or outside, make sure that they are positioned as follows: *On/Under, In front/Behind, Above/Below*. Give your child clear instructions as to where to find them one at a time, e.g. It's *under* a flower pot.

*Make it Easier:* Hide one egg at a time, changing the location, but sticking with same idea, e.g. putting it *under* something.

*Make it Harder:* Using the same amount of eggs, use language such as *left* and *right*. Ensuring your child knows their *left* from their *right*.
