
52 Things to Support your Child's

Speech and Language Skills.

Word tennis!

In this game you say a word, related to the word you just heard (making connections). Take it in turns.

dog-bone, bone-leg, leg-kick, kick-ball, ball-bat, bat-night, night-moon



Make it easier: Show your child how to play the game using a familiar toy, for example, a teddy bear. Say a word and then pretend to speak for the teddy saying an associated word. As your child understands the game, they can join teddy's team and say the answers.

Make it harder: For older children, ask them to explain the connection between the two words.

For example:

Dog - bone 'Because a dog eats a bone'

Bone-leg 'Because we have bones in our body and our leg'
