Clean Up, Clean Up!



The parent and the child take turns 'being in charge'.

Whoever is 'in charge' asks the other to complete 1-, 2-, or 3-step directions.

For example, "pick up the blue brick and the green crayon and put them away".

By taking turns being 'in charge', your child gets to practice listening skills as well as expressive language skills.

What You Are Working On:

- Vocabulary development
- Introduction to early developing concepts
- Ability to follow multi-step directions

By playing this game with your child, your child is learning direction words and listening skills.

Make it easier:

- Model the instruction for your child to see.

Make it harder:

- Start introducing some prepositions such as on, in, or under with your directions.
