 - Is this approach consistent with that taken towards the additional jobs growth for Solihull residents and the impacts on housing needs in Solihull?
 - Other factors affecting labour supply in these places e.g. housing and population growth increasing labour supply
 - Implications if there were upward pressure on housing need, particularly given inability of Birmingham/Black Country to meet their own needs already
 - How and when should the wider implications of jobs growth at UK Central and impact on housing need be addressed? Through this Local Plan? A review of this Local Plan? Emerging plans elsewhere?
