



Adoption of the Travel Plan Supplementary Planning Document

Statement of Adoption

9th January 2023

In accordance with Regulation 11 and 14 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012, notice is hereby given that Solihull Metropolitan Borough Council (SMBC) adopted the Travel Plan Supplementary Planning Document (SPD), hereafter referred to as the “Travel Plan SPD” on the 9th January 2023. This SPD was prepared to support the implementation of Policy P8 ‘Managing Travel Demand and Reducing Congestion’ of the SMBC Local Plan. The adopted Travel Plan SPD relates to the whole of the SMBC local authority area.

Any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of that decision. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after the date on which the SPD was adopted.
